

# Archery Road.

*Archery Road, named after the local archery club, is situated at the southern central area of the Barossa Valley. Highlighting the naturally beautiful landscape, Archery Road wines pay homage to the vineyards that sprawl across the ridges and valleys.*

## **Cabernet Sauvignon** *Barossa Valley* **2021**

### **Tasting Note:**

Fruit-driven and rich. This Barossa Cabernet displays notes of red-berry and wild dark cherry. With varietal characters of liquorice and pepper spice completing the rich round palate.

### **Analysis:**

14.5% alc/vol



### **Vinification:**

From a single-site vineyard in the Barossa Valley, the regions low-fertility clay loam soils make for intensely rich and opulent flavoured Cabernet grapes. Cool, wet winters and warm, dry summers ensure consistent and timely ripening of grapes conducive to full bodied reds with a riper fruit character and softer tannins than the Coonawarra or Margaret River.

### **Winemaking:**

Hand picked, lightly crushed, 15 days fermentation. Matured for 21 months in 28% new French hogsheads and barriques, balance in 1 and 2 year old French hogsheads & barriques.
