

# Archery Road.

*Archery Road, named after the local archery club, is situated at the southern central area of the Barossa Valley. Highlighting the naturally beautiful landscape, Archery Road wines pay homage to the vineyards that sprawl across the ridges and valleys.*

## **Shiraz** *Barossa Valley* **2021**

### **Tasting Note:**

Full-bodied and rich. This Barossa Shiraz displays notes of aromatic black fruit concentrates and touches of subtle oak. Fine tannins support the palate for a complex finish.

### **Analysis:**

14.5% alc/vol



### **Vinification:**

From a single-site vineyard in the Barossa Valley, the regions low-fertility clay loam soils make for powerful and flavourful Shiraz grapes. The Barossa Valley's warm and dry climate brings a fruity richness to the wine ensuring ripe fruit and robust tannins.

### **Winemaking:**

Hand picked, lightly crushed, 10 days fermentation. Matured for 15 months in 40% new French and American hogsheads and barriques.
